The safety fences and tables were all put away for the Winter on Saturday, November 6th with the help of Mark Josefowich, Ken Park, Dave Rees and Jack Cuss. Many thanks for the help guys.

The Winter snow clearing gear and sand, in the event of ice by the door, are all at the corner of the main door. When you are out during the snow season, please take a minute or two to clear the snow from in front of both the garage and entrance doors and move it well away from the building. I find it is a great way to warm up between flights!

The heat in the lounge area is set at a “low” setting and, if turned up for the flying session, it should be lowered again when leaving.

A couple of reminders for the seasoned Winter flyers and info for new members. All engine starts and runs are to be done outside the building. The garage area is to be used only for setup, and storing aircraft and equipment between flights. If you spill fuel in the garage area either on the floor or on the tables, please clean it up. Wear the snow shoes (which will be placed by the door when the snow arrives) to recover aircraft from the runway area to avoid leaving deep foot holes in the snow. They can ruin a take off or landing very effectively!
