This is a copy of the original club constitution from sometime in 1957, which was given to John Weekes at the 50th Anniversary by Lou McDonald, the original ORCC President, and we thought it was an interesting read. Keep it in mind, and see how things have changed the next time you read our current constitution.

CONSTITUTION

RADIO CONTROL MODEL CLUB

OBJECTIVE

To Foster, Aid, and Abet Radio Control of Models

MEMBERSHIP

The membership shall consist of permanent and temporary members:

Temporary -

- a. Is an amateur radio operator, electronic technician or a model builder who can demonstrate his ability to the membership.
- b. Receives 75% of ballots cast in a secret election.
- c. Is over 18 years of age.
- d. Membership is limited to one year.

Permanent -

- a. Is a temporary member.
- b. Has demonstrated a radio control model in action to a club member.

PROCEDURE

Temporary Membership -

- a. Apply to a club officer who will interview and screen the applicant.
- b. Applicant is introduced at the next club meeting and demonstrates his capability for temporary membership.
- c. The application is voted upon at the meeting and applicant notified prior to the next meeting.
- d. The \$5.00 initiation fee is paid the Treasurer.

Permanent Membership -

Permanent membership is assumed upon the introduction of a resolution by the witnessing member attesting to the model demonstration.

ATTENDANCE

All members shall have an annual 75% attendance record at regular meetings in order to retain membership. Special provisions may be made for absences caused by business or family requirements.

DUES

Membership dues shall be paid \$_____ annually or \$ _____ monthly.

QUORUM

A quorum shall consist of 50% of the membership.

VOTING

All members may vote on all issues placed before the club. Plurality shall apply at the election of club officers. All other issues require a 75% majority to carry.

CLUB OFFICES

President - Run club with full authority to hold club together, handles all functions and delegates authority as he sees fit. He must be a permanent member. Tenure is 1 year.

Vice President -Performs duties as determined by the President. Tenure is 1 year.

Secretary - Treasurer - Appointed by the President.

VOTE OF CONFIDENCE

The President and the Vice President may be challenged by a vote of confidence at any meeting at which they are absent. A vote of 75% nays shall remove the officer from office.
