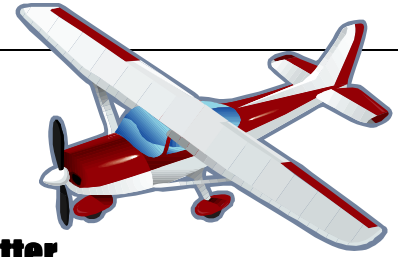

## **Sailplane Meeting Minutes by Brian Buchanan**

Sailplane Meeting November 14, 2006

1. Inter-club challenge series

Participation from the 3 clubs was discussed. We looked at the number of flyers from each club and the number of days flown by each club. ORCC participation was the highest with 39 competition days flown compared to 26 for MATS and 14 for C2VM. The group felt that the series was worthwhile and should continue for next season. We also agreed that the scoring system was working well with the final outcome being in doubt until the completion of the last round.

2. Training Night

A request was made to move training night back to Wednesday evenings. After some discussion, it was felt that Wednesday was a better night for training than Tuesday because it avoided club meeting and executive meeting nights. The decision was taken to move Training nights back to Wednesday evenings.

3. Frequency Pins

Aurele asked if there was any interest in having new frequency pins made. Some flyers now have synthesized transmitters and want a pin that the frequency can be written on and changed when required. Aurele will look into new frequency pins and bring the matter up at the next meeting of the ORCC executive.

The MAAC requirement for a sign describing the inherent dangers of flying RC was discussed. We will wait for the official wording of the signs to be announced and have a number of signs made up. Each person who carries glider launch device will also be required to carry and display a warning sign.

6. League of Silent Flight

Gudmund informed the group that he had received only 2 LSF requests from all of Canada during the past season. He felt this was not an onerous workload and could continue as the Canadian LSF contact person for another season.
