Special Guests at the Drummond Field by Ed King

On May 9, 2007 the weather was perfect for flying – the winds were light to calm and the temperature was warm. It was also a wonderful night for the Beavers of the 29 Nepean B Colony and their parents to visit the Ottawa Remote Control Club Drummond field. Although it was Wednesday training night, the Chief Instructor, Shahram Ghorashi graciously accepted the challenge of holding the attention of a group of twenty 5 to 7 year old Beavers. He and the other club members present more than succeeded.



After the Beavers did their opening ceremony at 6:30 PM, everyone was briefed on safety and led into the pit area to start the visit. The only anxious moment (for the author) came with some of the Beavers stretching over top of the aircraft being used for explanations in their enthusiasm to get the mosquitoes that also were visiting. Brent Norman and Shahram gave terrific age-appropriate explanations on basic aerodynamics and flight controls. Corey Groves was on hand to provide some insight into helicopter mechanics and then went on to give

captivating flight demos with his big nitro helicopter and later with his electric ducted-fan jet. The questions came not only from the Beavers but also their parents. Interest was expressed in the club and how to get started. Many inquired as to when they could return to spectate. It was truly pleasant to see the number of students out learning to fly and the range of their ages. Their flying filled in the gaps quite nicely with the occasional thrill.
