**Let's have a record turnout!**

The Ottawa Remote Control Club (ORCC) is hosting the annual Doug Pinhey Float Fly on Friday, June 26, 2004. This year marks the 10th anniversary of the float fly which began in 1995. Doug Pinhey was a long time member of the ORCC and a very active R/C flyer. Doug's achievements include building and flying scale models for the CBC series "Flight: A Passionate Affair" which documented the history of flight in Canada.

Doug was a very active float flyer. Upon his death, his family donated a trophy intended for ORCC float flying events. The Doug Pinhey Float Fly has is a non-competitive, fun-fly event with the trophy being awarded on a random draw basis. Each flyer is awarded a ticket for each flight they make thus promoting as many flights as possible during the event. In past years, we have had flyers from Kingston, Cornwall, Montreal and even New-York state come to the event.

For 2004, we have moved the event to late June in hopes of attracting better weather and more flyers. This year, the club is absorbing a deficit for the event (to cover the cost of chilli, drinks, and hot dogs) but would like to receive funding of \$100 for prizes and gift certificates. These prizes would be awarded on a random basis thus ensuring all registered flyers have an equal opportunity to benefit

This donation would be used support local hobby shops which are major supporters of the ORCC in all aspects of the club and the hobby in general. The intent is to purchase \$50 in prizes and gift certificates from each of Discount Hobbies and Dynamic Hobbies
