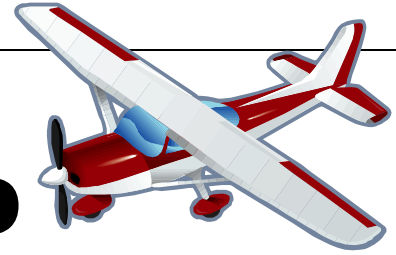

A safety message from your ORCC Prez:

We all need to become more vigilant in our attention to safety at the flying field. Remember that we should only fire up our engines in the designated start-up areas and to orient your aircraft away from the pits while starting. The same rules apply for electric airplanes - batteries to be plugged in only in the start-up areas, even if it is only a small park flier or a 300-size heli. As you are flying, always keep your airplane on the correct side of the flight line, and make sure you call your take-offs, landings, low-passes and so on. Pilots are strongly encouraged to use a spotter to watch for hazards. It would be good for all of us as responsible modelers to re-read the MAAC safety code and make sure we are fully complying with the safety rules. If you see something unsafe, please say something. Safety is the responsibility of all of us. We have to look out for each other! Have fun, enjoy the hobby, and fly safely.

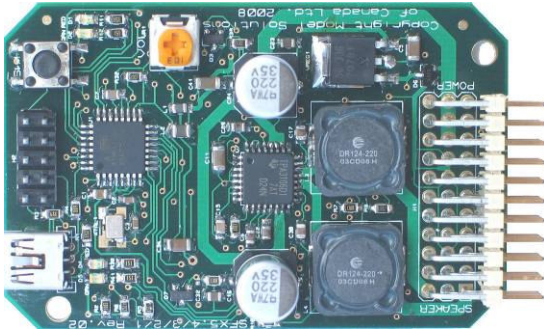
